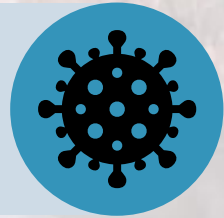

COVID 19 CONSIDERATIONS

To allow for possible Covid restrictions, the following back up plans are in place:



LEVEL 1 - No restrictions in place, event will run as planned.

LEVEL 2 - Possible Australia/New Zealand border closed:

- All three international adjudicators are contracted to be available for a live stream to their homes from our event at Hawkins Theatre.
- Timetable will be staggered to cater to the venue & Ministry of Health capacity numbers.
- Some sections may be omitted (i.e., teams, with refunds provided) OR combined (i.e., Intermediate & Open).
- **LEVELS 3 & 4** - Our event will be cancelled due to the Ministry of Health's alert level requirements

At all levels, attendees should follow the recommended MOH guidelines and use the QR Covid tracer app.

JUDGE REPLACEMENT

If any of our adjudicators' states go into a lockdown (preventing their travel), the following steps will be taken:

- If there is more than 24 hours notice, where possible the adjudicator(s) will be replaced from a Covid safe State within Australia.
- If there is less than 24 hours notice, we will utilize New Zealand Adjudicators, where possible over the weekend who do not have associations or competitors in those sections.
- If all 3 Australian judges are unable to travel and replacements are not available, we will live stream to the contracted judges into their homes, via a secure and private non-recorded video link.



We reserve the right to amend this syllabus to facilitate COVID 19 restrictions. It is only by working together with a flexible, understanding and co-operative outlook, that this event can take place.

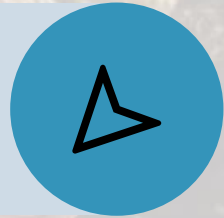
- ✓ A large wooden stage and great lighting.

Doing single timing, basic steps.



\$10 per dance, 1 judge:

Light Jig (116 bpm)
Single Slip Jig (124 bpm)
Single Jig (124 bpm)

City of Sails Special - \$15, 2 judges:

Single Reel (122-124 bpm)

- Beginners must wear a beginner level or school costume as per CLRG rules.
- All dances are 40 bars.
- Age groups will be split once entries are received but will have no less than 5 dancers in a group.
- This section will be danced with Novice, with results given separately for each dance and grade.
- Beginners can also enter Novice for any number of dances which will make them eligible for results from both grades.

\$10 per dance, 1 judge:

Single Reel (122-124 bpm)
Single Slip Jig (124 bpm)
Single Jig (124 bpm)
Trad Heavy Jig (96 bpm)
Trad Hornpipe (144bpm)
Choice of Traditional Set

City of Sails Special - \$15, 2 judges:

Light Jig (116 bpm)

- Novices must wear a beginner level or school costume as per CLRG rules.
- All dances are 40 bars.
- Age groups will be split once entries are received but will have no less than 5 dancers in a group.
- This section will be danced with Beginners, with results given separately for each dance and grade.
- These dancers can also enter the Primary rounds.



NOVICE Rounds.

Dancers in their 1st, 2nd or 3rd year of competition.
Doing single timing, basic steps.

PRIMARY Rounds.
Dancers who are heading to their first
Nationals this year, doing basic open work.



\$10 per dance, 1 judge:

Under 9 age groups as per 2021 TIDANZ Nationals Syllabus
Under 10 and over:
Reel or Slip Jig
Jig or Hornpipe

City of Sails Special - \$15, 2 judges:

Under 9 age groups as per 2021 TIDANZ Nationals Syllabus
Under 10 and over: Choice of Set

- This section will be danced with Intermediate, with results given separately for each dance from 1 judge.
- Age groups to be spilt once entries are received but will have no less than 5 dancers in a group.
- These dancers can also enter Intermediate and will be eligible for the Intermediate overall results from both judges for an additional \$30

INTERMEDIATE PREMIERSHIP - \$45, 2 judges:

Under 9 age groups as per 2021 TIDANZ Nationals Syllabus
Under 10 and over:
Reel or Slip Jig
Jig or Hornpipe
Choice of Set

- This section will be danced with Primary, with overall results given for Intermediate separately to the Primary results.
- Age groups to be spilt once entries are received but will have no less than 5 dancers in a group.
- These dancers can also enter Open. The price for entering both is \$110



INTERMEDIATE Premiership.

Dancers who did not place in the top 50% at either of
the last 2 New Zealand Championships (or State
Championships for Australian entries).

ENTRY FEES & SYLLABUS FOR OPEN & ADULT B

OPEN Championship.



OPEN - \$75, 3 Judges:

Under 9 age groups as per 2021 TIDA NZ Nationals Syllabus

Under 10 and over:

Reel or Slip Jig

Jig or Hornpipe

Choice of Set

- Single Age Groups starting at the Under 10 age group upwards.
- However, if there are less than 5 dancers entered for an age group, they will be combined up or down to a double age group.
- 17 & Over is likely to be the oldest age group.

ADULT B - \$75, 3 Judges:

Reel or Slip Jig (open length)

Jig or Hornpipe (32 bars)

Choice of Trad Set

- These dancers can also enter Intermediate for an additional \$35



ADULT B Championship

Either dancers over 18 who did not take classes as a juvenile or dancers over 18 who have taken more than 5 years off with no competition

ENTRY FEES & SYLLABUS FOR ADULT A & TEAMS COSTS FOR VENUE & PROGRAM

Adult A Rounds.

Either dancers over the age of 18 who did not take classes as a juvenile or over 35 who did not take classes after the age of 10

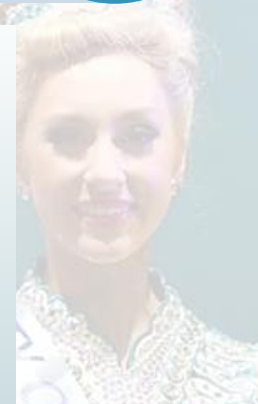

- Adult A dancers must wear a beginner level or school costume as per CLRG rules.
- All dances are 40 bars
- These dancers can also enter Adult B for an additional \$65



Teams - \$8 per dancer per dance – 3 judges

4, 6 & 8 Hand Commission Book Ceili's.

Age groups and dances as per the 2021 TIDANZ Nationals Syllabus.

\$25 Family venue fee

Compulsory venue fee per family which includes 4 one-day wristbands.

Spectator fee \$10 per day, per person

Available at the venue, non-dancing children under 12 free.

Program \$10/\$12

GENERAL CONDITIONS

This event is conducted under the rules and regulations of an Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha, TIDANZ rules and the 2021 TIDANZ Grading Syllabus



1) In order for entries to be accepted, teachers must note that all competitors:

a. Are pupils of teachers who at the date of entry are registered with An Coimisiún for the year 2021. New Zealand dancers must be registered with TIDANZ.

b. Must not, on the date(s) of their competitions(s), be ineligible to compete due to any rule.

c. Must have been formally entered and have had their entry fees paid in full in due time in accordance with these rules and the general rules of the organising committee.

2) Entries will be accepted from teachers only, emailed to cityofsails@doyleacademy.co.nz on the provided spreadsheet, one payment per school. ANZ Bank 01-0142-0134012-01 Doyle Academy.

3) Entries will be open until 9pm NZT Friday 16 July 2021.

4) Late entries will be accepted up until 9pm NZT Friday 23rd July 2021, with a late fee of \$20 NZD per dancer.

5) It is the responsibility of the teacher(s) to ensure that the entry submitted is correct.

6) All entries will be checked against the 2021 TIDANZ list of registered dancers.

7) The City of Sails Championship has a NO REFUND policy on all entries paid, except for government regulations prohibiting an individual from travelling to the event. Individuals would need to apply directly to the committee via their email cityofsails@doyleacademy.co.nz with details of any situation that may arise.

8) Lodgement of any entry shall be taken to signify that the teacher, parent or guardian and pupil concerned accepts, in full, all the rules of this event and agrees to strictly abide by them at all times.



The age of a competitor shall be taken as on 1st January, 2021. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1st January they shall, for the purpose of the championship, be regarded as under the age attained on that day.
