SYLLABUS:

Age groups will be determined and split when all entries are received.

ELIGIBILITY:

Dancers where eligible can enter more than one level. Please refer to the TIDANZ Grading Syllabus.

INDIVIDUAL WARM UP ROUNDS:

Each dance result placed to 50% of dancers who dance on the day.

Dancers in the beginners and novice sections will have additional highly commended awards.

If five or less dance, all five dancers will be placed.

AGGREGATE ROUNDS:

Both rounds are added together for an overall result.

Prizes will be awarded to the top THREE dancers who danced on the day and completed both rounds.

SPECIAL SECTIONS/TROPHY DANCES:

Prizes will be awarded to the top THREE dancers for each section/dance.



Conditions of Entry

1. Official entry form provided must be used for dancer/school entry & received from teachers with one payment per school.

2. In order for entries to be accepted, teachers must note that all competitors:

a. are pupils of teachers who at the date of entry are registered with An Coimisiún for the year 2023/2024.

b. New Zealand dancers must be registered with TIDANZ.

c. must not, on the date(s) of their competitions(s), be ineligible to compete due to any rule.

3. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry submitted is correct.

4. This feis is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha and the Traditional Irish Dancing Association (TIDANZ)

5. The age of a competitor shall be taken as on 1st January 2024. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1st January, he/she shall, for the purpose of the Championship, be regarded as under the age attained on that day.
