CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Official entry form provided must be used for dancer/school entry & received from teachers with one payment per school.
2. In order for entries to be accepted, teachers must note that all competitors:
 - a. are pupils of teachers who at the date of entry are registered with An Coimisiún for the year 2019-2020.
 - b. New Zealand dancers must be registered with TIDA NZ.
 - c. must not, on the date(s) of their competitions(s), be ineligible to compete due to any rule.
3. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry submitted is correct.
4. This feis is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha and the Traditional Irish Dancing Association (TIDANZ)
5. The age of a competitor shall be taken as on 1st January 2020. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1st January, he/she shall, for the purpose of the Championship, be regarded as under the age attained on that day.
6. No refunds will be given to any dancer if they CANNOT attend or participate once their entry has been submitted.
7. If the competition is canceled (once entry names & fees are paid) due to changes to the Ministry of Health and New Zealand Government Alert levels, refunds will be made minus any non refundable deposits made by the organising committee for venue, awards & adjudicators travel expenses.

SYLLABUS: Age groups will be determined and split when all entries are received.
Dancers may only enter one level of dancing for the day.

RESULTS: All sections will be given individual results for each dance.
Individual Rounds will be placed to 50% of dancers who dance on the day.
Beginners and novice sections will be awarded highly commended.
If four or less dance, all four dancers will be placed.
No overall places awarded for Beginners, Novice & Adult A sections.
Adult B, Intermediate and Open sections will have trophies for overall top 3.

BEGINNER SECTION

Dancers new to Irish dancing and are in their first registered year of competing.

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules. Low-cut tops and short, tight skirts are not permitted.

Makeup, false eyelashes and tanner on the face is not permitted for dancers in all age groups at this level

NOVICE SECTION

Dancers are in their second or third year of competition.

Dancers can compete in this section for maximum of two years. They have not placed or recalled at an intermediate premiership or open level Championship (i.e. City of Sails, New Zealand Championships)

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules. Low-cut tops and short, tight skirts are not permitted.

Makeup, false eyelashes and tanner on the face is not permitted for dancers all age groups in this level.

INTERMEDIATE SECTION

Dancers who have not recalled/placed (top 50%) at a NZ Championship in either 2018 or 2019.

Make-up & tanner on the face not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under 10 age group.

First Round: Jig or Hornpipe or Light Jig (Under 8 only) Second Round: Reel or Slip Jig Third Round: Traditional or Open Set	\$45 per dancer

OPEN SECTION

Dancers who have recalled/placed at any open level Championship (City of Sails, New Zealand Championships)

Make-up & tanner on the face not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under 10 age group.

First Round: Jig or Hornpipe or Light Jig (Under 8 only) Second Round: Reel or Slip Jig Third Round: Traditional (Under 9 only) or Open Set	\$45 per dancer

ADULT A

Dancers over the age of 18 years who did not take Irish dance classes as a juvenile or dancers over 35 who did not take Irish dance classes after the age of 10.

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules.

Ladies are required to wear opaque black tights of a denier not less than 70.

ADULT B

Dancers over the age of 18 years who did not take Irish dance classes as a juvenile or dancers over the age of 18 years who have taken more than 5 years off with no Irish dance competition.

Dancers can wear a solo costume and make-up. Ladies are required to wear opaque black tights not less than 70 denier.

Dancers can enter this section for no longer than three years.
