CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Official entry form provided must be used for all entries & received from teachers with one payment per school due by FRIDAY 3RD MAY 2024. Capital City Feis 12-3493-0070974-00. Reference – Dancing school name.
- 2. It is the responsibility of teachers to ensure that the entry submitted is correct and that all dancers are registered with TIDA NZ.
- 3. This feis is conducted under the rules and regulations of An Coimisúin le Rincí Gaelacha and the Traditional Irish Dancing Association of NZ.
- 4. Age groups will be determined and split when all entries are received.

- 5. Dancers can enter a maximum of 3 individual rounds (NOT including the Moghane Trophy or the Contemporary sections). Dancers may compete in only one grade at this feis.
- 6. Results: 50% of dancers who compete on the day will be placed, with the exception of the Moghane Trophy. In the Intermediate, Open & Adult B sections only, the 3 solo rounds will be added together for an overall result.
- 7. Teachers may video their own dancers in the Contemporary sections only, from the designated video area.
- 8. Photographs and videos of the Presentation Ceremonies may be used by Gregan Irish Dancers NZ for promotional purposes.

AWARDS

The Champions Trophy: This Trophy will be presented to the winner of each Open section. It is a perpetual trophy which will be held by the Capital City Irish Feis. Winners will receive a miniature trophy.

The Peter Hannigan Memorial Cup: This will be presented to the winner of each of the Boys Open sections. It is a perpetual trophy which will be held by the Capital City Irish Feis. Winners will receive a miniature trophy to keep.

The Moghane Trophy: Awarded to the winner, this is a perpetual trophy which will be held by the Capital City Irish Feis.

Aislinn Ryan Tribute Award for the Top Dancer: Awarded to the Open dancer with the most points.

Capital City Feis Medal: Novice Dancer Showing Most Promise.

Capital City Feis Medal: Most Outstanding Primary Dancer.
