CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. This competition is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of An Coimisiumn le Rinci Gaelacha and the Traditional Irish Dancing Association (TIDANZ)
- 2. Dancers must be registered with TIDANZ to be eligible to enter this competition.
- 3. The official entry form provided must be used for dancer/school entry and received from teachers with one payment per school.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry submitted is correct.
- 5. The age of the competitor shall be taken as on 1st January 2021. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1st January they shall, for the purpose of the competition, be regarded as under the age attained on that date.
- 6. Age groups will be determined and split when all entries are received.
- 7. Dancers, where eligible can dance in their BASE grade level and one above. Grades for dancers are determined by the TIDA of NZ Grading Syllabus.

CANCELLATION:

If this competition has to be cancelled due to any changes in the Covid-19 alert levels, any entry fees paid will be returned to schools minus the administration fee (\$15) which will be kept to cover costs incurred for the event.

DANCE TO THE MUSIC (FOR NON-REGISTERED DANCERS): FREE TO ENTER.

Entries taken on the day. Music will be the Beginners Reel. Dancers from the same school will dance together in groups.

CONTEMPORARY SECTIONS

FREE to enter for dancers already entered in other sections.

Dancers/teachers must indicate on the entry form that they have parental/guardian consent to send a video entry in. Actual video entries can be sent up to one week prior to the competition (last date to send an entry in is Friday 2^{nd} July).

This year, the contemporary sections will be Video-entry only. These sections can go ahead at all alert levels. If we are at Level 1 at the time of the competition, all video entries will be played on a projector for the audience and will be judged live at the competition. If at Level 2, 3, or 4, videos will be judged by our adjudicator, and results will be posted to our "Christchurch Competitions Irish Dance Section" Facebook Page. The videos of winning entries will be posted to this page with permission from dancers' parents/guardians. We ask that all entrants wait to post their entries to social media until after the results have been announced.

General Rules for all Contemporary Sections: Videos must be filmed in one take. They can either include hard and/or soft shoe and may combine other forms of dance. Dancers must perform own choreography, to their choice of music, with choice of costumes and background. Dancers from different schools may form teams.

How to send your Video Entry:

- Go to wetransfer.com
- Click the + and upload your video file

- In the message, please write the name of the dancer/s in the video, and which section they are entering
- Click "Transfer"

The organisers will check the video can be played and will be in contact within 24 hours to notify that your entry has been received.

Sections:

Contemporary Solo or Duo. Dancers may only enter once either as a soloist or in a duo.

Under 13: Maximum 1 minute.

Over 13: Maximum 1 minute.

Open Contemporary Irish Team: 3 or more dancers. Dancers may only enter in one team. Minimum 1 minute, maximum 3 minutes.

Marks will be awarded in the Contemporary sections as follows:

Original Choreography (incl steps and arm movements) /30 Entertainment value (incl music choice) /20

Technique (incl skill level, accuracy, posture, and timing) /30

Presentation (incl costumes, props, choice of background) /20
